1. Rehearsal is at 6:30 pm Friday, May 6th at The Plaza Arts Center. Contestants do not have to dress up for this but may wear their pageant shoes to get used to walking on the stage in them. ***** PLEASE BE PRESENT** – Important information about pictures, details and times will be announced at Rehearsal. ***Due to an added category, the format will vary this year from past pageants.***
2. Contestants will be judged in 5 age groups with 1st, 2nd, 3rd places and Miss Congeniality from each:
 - **Pre-K4 - Kindergarten: Tiny Miss**
 - **1st - 2nd Grade: Petite Miss**
 - **3rd - 5th Grade: Little Miss**
 - **6th - 8th Grade: Junior Miss**
 - **9th - 12th Grade: Dairy Festival Queen ~ Sponsored by the Eatonton Pilot Club~**
****prizes donated by Eatonton Pilot Club will be given for Queen category****
 - * ***Dairy Festival Queen: \$1,000 prize***
 - * ***1st runner up: \$500 prize***
 - * ***2nd runner up: \$250 prize***
3. Outside flowers **will** be allowed this year. ESL will **NOT** be selling flowers at the door. **No** balloons, noise makers, etc. are allowed - only flowers to be given to the contestants after the pageant.
4. Entrance fees at the door the day of the pageant for everyone except contestants are:
\$7 for adults, \$3 children under 12.
5. A professional photographer will be available the day of the pageant.
6. **Contestants Pre K-5th Grade are required to wear church, flower girl or Easter type dresses. (No Pageant Style Dresses - Contestants who are overdressed the day of pageant will not be judged.)**
7. **Contestants 6th-12th Grade MAY wear pageant/prom style dresses.**

**ESL Pageant
Rules and Release Form**

1. All participants must live or attend school in Putnam County.
2. **Contestants PreK4 through 5th Grade are required to wear church, flower girl or Easter type dresses. (No Pageant Style Dresses - Contestants who are overdressed the day of pageant will not be judged.)**
3. **Contestants 6th-12th Grade MAY wear pageant/prom style dresses.**
4. Judges' decisions are final! Talking with the Judges before, during, or after the pageant is prohibited. If any family, friend, or the contestant herself is caught violating this rule, the contestant will be disqualified and forfeiture of any and all awards received.
5. Parents are not allowed in holding rooms or backstage.
5. Good sportsmanship and behavior is required at all times. Failure to show good sportsmanship (including any family or friend of the contestant) or proper behavior, backstage and otherwise, will result in disqualification of the contestant without refund and forfeiture of any and all awards received. It may also result in contestant not being allowed to compete in the pageant the following year. This rule applies to before, during, and after the pageant.
6. All registration/entry fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable.
7. The Eatonton Service League, Inc. is not responsible for loss due to injury incurred at, or in travel to and from the pageant. We are not responsible for any thefts that may occur.
8. The Eatonton Service League, Inc. Pageant requires high moral standards; therefore any contestant or representative caught engaged in such acts, such as drinking alcohol, taking drugs, smoking, foul language, bullying, etc., will be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the directors.
9. **I understand it is mandatory for Winners and Runner-ups to ride on the float in the Dairy Festival Parade and be present at the courthouse afterward for the presentations. The float meets at Putnam County Elementary School at 9:30 a.m. the first Saturday in June.**

***The Dairy Festival Queen will be asked to perform some duties during her reign as queen, such as attending the pageant next year for the crowning of the next queen and attending at least 1 of ESL's events as a service to our community, such as our annual road race or toy drive at Christmas.*

As the parents/legal guardian of the participant named below, I do hereby acknowledge that I have read and fully understand the rules and agree to abide by the rules and release as set forth by the The Eatonton Service League Pageant. I hereby waive and release any and all rights that either my heirs, successors and assigns or I may have against The Eatonton Service League, Inc., The Plaza Arts Center (or alternate location), The Pilot Club, their agents, servants, and/or employees, arising from my participation in this event, including, but not limited to property damage and injuries. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless all of the foregoing from any claim which may be made by me or on behalf by other third parties which might be made against me by others, arising from my participation in the foregoing event. I understand that good sportsmanship is required at all times. This includes the contestant, parents, and /or guests. I understand that failure to show good sportsmanship will result in disqualification of the contestant without refund and forfeiture of any awards received. I agree and understand that all fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable. I release my image and agree and give my permission to The Eatonton Service League, Inc. and The Pilot Club to use any and all photographs and or videotapes for publicity purposes on their website, Facebook pages, advertisements, or any ESL Pageant materials and in the local newspaper. This form is to be signed by the parent or legally responsible guardian. I am aware that by placing in the pageant my child will be required to ride on the ESL or Pilot Club sponsored float in the Dairy Festival Parade and that I or my minor child may be exposed to possible personal injury as well as possible damage to my or my minor child's property. I agree to assume full responsibility for my or my minor child's safety and the safety of my or my minor child's property while participating in the Parade. I also assume full responsibility while in transit to and from the Parade. I also agree to keep my child home from rehearsal and/or pageant if she presents any sign of fever/sickness.
